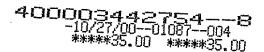

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WORLDWIDE CREDIT CORPORATION.

The undersigned, a natural person of full age, for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act, as amended, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be Worldwide Credit Corporation.

ARTICLE II.

This corporation is organized for and shall have general business purposes.

This corporation shall have without limitation all the powers granted to or available to business corporations under the laws of the State of Minnesota. The purposes and powers of this corporation shall not be deemed limited or restricted in any manner, but shall be to engage in any business lawful for a corporation having general business purposes under the Minnesota Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III.

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Minnesota is 385 Washington Street, St. Paul, Minnesota 55102.

ARTICLE IV.

The existence of this corporation shall commence upon issuance of the Certificate of Incorporation by the Secretary of State of Minnesota, and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V.

(a) The capital stock of this corporation shall consist

of 25,000 shares of common stock. Each share of common stock shall have a par value of one dollar (\$1.00).

- (b) The holder of each share of common stock shall be entitled to one vote for each share of common stock held by him. There shall be no cumulative voting.
- (c) The shareholder shall have no pre-emptive right to subscribe for or purchase additional shares of this corporation.
- (d) The authorized capital stock of this corporation shall be issued in the manner, at such times, in such amounts. and for such considerations, in money or property or both, as the Board of Directors may, from time to time determine.
- (e) The presence, in person or by proxy, of the holders of a majority of the shares entitled to vote at any meeting of the shareholders shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business unless the By-Laws or the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act specify otherwise.

ARTICLE VI.

The amount of stated capital with which this corporation shall begin business shall be in the sum of \$1,000.00.

ARTICLE VII.

(a) The management of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors of not less than three (3) or more than fifteen (15) in number. The number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of elections, time and place of meetings, and powers and duties of directors shall be fixed by the By-Laws of this corporation. The first Board of Directors of the corporation, who shall hold office until their respective successors are duly elected and qualified shall consist of:

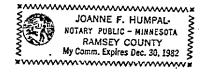

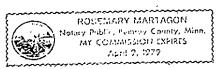

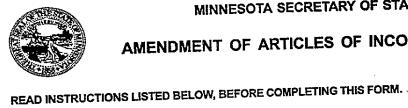
